**Arrivals/Departures:** To coordinate the arrivals and departures of all teams and officials. To provide Protocol support in facilitating VIP handling.

**Transportation:** To ensure orderly and timely movement of teams, officials and VIPs to and from all official activities during the Games.

**Housing:** To provide accommodations for all athletes, officials and VIPs during the Games.

**Catering:** To ensure that all athletes and officials are provided with nutritious meals (breakfast, lunch, and dinner) throughout the duration of the Games.

**Security:** To ensure the safety of all participants at all venues and housing sites

**Medical:** to ensure timely attention to all teams and officials requiring medical services, provide emergency services at all venues; a clinic at the housing sites and expeditious transfer to Belau National Hospital, if necessary.

#### **FINANCE COMMITTEE**

Responsible for Fundraising, Marketing and Public Relations, Concessionaires, Communications, and Legal Activities before, during, and after the Games.

**Fundraising:** To solicit funds, produce and sell commodities, and to promote corporate sponsorship of the Games.

**Marketing/Public Relations:** To ensure a well-organized campaign to educate the public and promote the goals of the Games.

**Legal:** To provide MGOC with any legal assistance or guidance when needed.

**Communications:** To ensure the accurate and timely handling of all information.

#### **CEREMONIES COMMITTEE**

Responsible for the official presentations to all 2010 Micronesian Games Participants: athletes, coaches, officials and VIPs. Including the Opening and Closing

Ceremonies; Flag and Medal Ceremonies, Protocol and Official Functions.

**Protocol:** To ensure that all necessary support is provided to attending VIPs.

**Opening and Closing Ceremonies:** To present and appropriate well-choreographed programs with an emphasis on sports, culture and national pride.

#### **CULTURAL COMMITTEE**

Responsible for the official and proper presentation of all cultural displays, presentations and performances, coordinate all off-island presentations and provide for the efficient operations of the Entertainment and Recreation Centers.

**Entertainment & Recreation Centers:** To ensure coordination and smooth running of the Micronesian Cultural presentations, timely scheduling of entertainment at the "Cultural Pavilion", and to ensure the establishment, management and operations of the Recreation Centers at the Athletes' Village.

#### **VOLUNTEERS COMMITTEE**

Develop strategy for the Call For, coordination, organization, training, and scheduling of all volunteers needed for the 2010 Micronesian Games to include providing incentives and other logistic needs and services of the Volunteers.

**Training:** To develop a General Briefing training session for all Volunteers and in coordination with the various subcommittees, develop specific training sessions for those volunteers.

## GENERAL OBJECTIVES

Governing Body : Micronesian Games Council

### I. Objectives

- To create bonds of kindred, friendship and brotherhood amongst the people of Micronesia;
- To promote sports in these islands;
- To ensure efficient promotion of sports amongst these people;
- To promote the Micronesian Games, which shall be held every four years.
- To encourage and assist sport and sport development and physical recreation throughout these island nations;
- To support fair and drug free competition between the athletes of the Micronesian community and for such purpose to adopt and implement the provisions of the Code of the World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA).
- To promote the Olympic Movement by exercising the three Olympic Values of *excellence, friendship and respect*; at the same

time adhering to the fundamental Olympic principals of *Non-discrimination, Sustainability, Humanism, Universality, Solidarity and Alliance between sport, education and culture.*

### II. Sports

- There shall be three (3) compulsory sports in the Games. Each host nation may choose which sports they can best organize and must be approved by the Council.
- For any sport to be on the Program, the sport must be practiced regularly and annually by at least 50% of the member islands.
- Host nations are encouraged to host as many female sports as possible.
- Sundays will be optional days for sports.
